

Guided walks – some practicalities

Participants should dress to suit the weather conditions and wear suitable and comfortable footwear.

The **church walk** will follow the pavements and unmade paths across the common. Please bear in mind the distance between the churches – each of the walks across the common to and from the Annunciation is approximately 1 mile or so in length. Whilst there will be opportunities to sit in each of the churches you will be on your feet for most of the session.

The **village walk** will follow the pavements and unmade paths across the common. You will be on your feet for the duration of walk

For both walks, please bear in mind that the weather conditions can be changeable – bring an umbrella/waterproofs if it is wet.

Participants will be expected to behave responsibly and undertake the walk at their own risk.

Road parking cannot be guaranteed but is normally available in the vicinity of St Nicholas Church. Chislehurst is served both by a regular train service and a number of bus routes. Public lavatories are available at Sainsbury's on the High Street or in the nearby pubs.

If you wish to take part in the church walk event but are unsure that you can comfortably manage the walks between the churches please contact the festival organisers. There is the possibility of driving between them and rejoining the walking group at each church (there is a public car park near the Annunciation and road parking in the vicinity of the other two churches).
